

Krogen 44

In 2012, Kadey Krogen announced that it would offer a redesigned version of the Krogen 44 that had a successful launch in 2011: 26 hulls were built following its debut. The new model, the 44 AE, replaces the original 44 and will make its international debut at the 2013 Miami International Boat Show. It's an exciting boat for the builder as it represents a collaborative creative effort between owners, prospective owners and the builder's in-house design



team led by naval architect Dave Glasco. According to the company, there are more than 50 ergonomic and technical changes that differentiate the 44 AE from her predecessor. Among them are full-sized cockpit boarding doors, walk-in engine room access, a companion seat next to the helm chair on the larger flybridge where there's also corner bench seating for entertaining. In addition, the galley has been redesigned to accommodate a four-burner Viking range and an 18-cubic foot refrigerator that opens to port for the chef's convenience. Technical upgrades include LED lighting and a new engine room ventilation system that employs intake and exhaust axial fans. In addition to a master suite, there's a second cabin that can be set up as a den/office, as a space for children to sleep with twin berths, or as a dedicated guest stateroom with a queen berth. With a LOA of 49' and a beam of 15'6", the boat carries 850 gallons of fuel. Max range is 4,450 nautical miles running at 6 knots. Power up to 9 knots for a range of 1,250. kadeykrogen.com
