

About the Krogen 50 Open

The Krogen 50 Open perfectly represents our company philosophy and dedicated focus developed (and perfected) from nearly 50 years of boatbuilding. First it meets the key objective of delivering a comfortable and efficient long-range cruising yacht on our proven Pure Full Displacement hull form. Then, it wipes the slate clean with a refreshing interior layout and use of space—the pilothouse, galley, and salon form one seamless space on the main deck, with a layout that invites entertainment and casual living on board.

The main deck interior is what sets the 50 Open apart: The galley is located between the light-filled salon and the pilothouse. Equipped for a gourmet chef, the galley is complete with a Sub-Zero refrigerator/freezer, Viking range, abundant stowage, and 16 linear feet of counter space.

The 50 Open is available with either an amidships master or an optional master-forward design. The amidships master arrangement has a retreat-like master stateroom that features an island queen berth, an en suite head with his-and-hers sinks, and a large walk-in shower. A spacious VIP cabin is situated forward and includes a deluxe queen berth and private head. A full-size washer and dryer and a dedicated linen locker are conveniently located between the staterooms. An optional three-stateroom layout is also available for the cruising family.

A walk-in, stand-up engine room with six and a half feet of headroom (seven feet at the forward portion) houses either single or twin John Deere diesels and the industry's finest systems and equipment. When experienced cruisers explore a Krogen engine room, it's often what they don't see that makes as significant of an impression as what they do see. For one, we do not overload our designs with untried and unreliable equipment. To us, reliability and safety outweigh experimenting with some new unproven piece of technology. Then everything is laid out for accessibility and ease of maintenance. In our view, if you're able to reach the machinery easily, chances are it will be better maintained.

The Krogen 50 Open benefits from the same attention to load distribution and utilization on reducing weight while maximizing strength. Hull construction includes use of American-made Cook gelcoat. Hand-laid Knytex fiberglass construction with Corecell closed-cell PVC sandwich core is utilized in the topsides. Below the waterline you'll find solid fiberglass with blister-resistant vinyl ester resin utilized on the first two laminates, with aramid fiber/FRP reinforcements. It's no wonder that the Krogen 50 Open has become one of the most popular models within our entire line.

A HOME ON THE WATER

The Krogen 50 Open combines Krogen's trademark ocean-crossing prowess with the creature comforts needed for extended cruising to create a true home on the water. From the massive master ensuite head in the standard accommodations plan to the small thoughtful touches like lights reminiscent of those found in a country home and plentiful stowage, we build boats to ensure that our owners have everything they need to venture further, stay out longer, and fulfill their cruising dreams.

An optional lower deck layout features three staterooms including a double berth plan in this guest stateroom, ideal for cruising with kids or extended family.



The Krogen 50 Open provides the ideal layout for the cruising couple, with an expansive single-level living space stretching from the aft deck all the way forward to the open pilothouse. For increased privacy or traditional pilothouse passagemaking, the 50 Open is optimized with a remote-controlled, retractable wall to separate the helm area from the salon and galley.





The pilothouse has surfaces for chartwork, while port and starboard side doors offer quick deck access and fresh air.



LIVEBOARDS WELCOME

The Krogen 50 Open fulfills our goal of making our customers feel at home at any sea by providing them with an interior layout that is bright, airy, open, and filled with home-like comforts. The amidships master is huge, with opening ports to bring in natural light and plenty of fresh air. The main deck arrangement creates a single, open living space that flows from the salon, to the galley, and up into the pilothouse. However these comforts don't replace the ship-like features our owners love, like ample space for electronics in the pilothouse, quick access to side decks, and robust systems.

The amidships owner's stateroom is on the centerline to ensure comfort while underway or at anchor.

AN OWNER-OPERATOR'S DREAMS

At Krogen Yachts, we build boats for clients who really use their boats. And while we're not going to turn our nose up at a lovely sunset cruise through the harbor, the true majesty of the Krogen 50 Open, like all our yachts, is found at sea. Owner-operators will appreciate conveniences such as port and starboard wing stations for tight-quarters docking or short-handed operation, the walk-in engine room that will make any mechanically-inclined owner swoon, and the stacked washer/dryer.



The large engine room, accessible via a watertight door in the cockpit lazarette, is clean and bright, with all essential elements clearly visible and well within reach.


BRIDGE DECK

Even with a large tender on the chocks, this upper deck has room for entertaining.




MAIN DECK
